Charles Dziuban is Director of the Research Initiative for Teaching Effectiveness at the University of Central Florida (UCF). He has taught research design and statistics since 1970. Since 1996, he has directed the impact evaluation of UCF's distributed learning initiative, examining student and faculty outcomes and gauging the impact of online courses on the university. Chuck has published in numerous journals including Multivariate Behavioral Research, Psychological Bulletin, and Educational and Psychological Measurement. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin.
