

If you fall into one of the priority target groups listed below

- Pregnant women
- People living with or caring for infants under 6 months of age
- Emergency medical services personnel and health care workers
- Children and young adults from 6 months through 24 years
- People aged 25 through 64 years with chronic medical conditions

the USC University Park Health Center plans an H1N1 flu vaccination outreach this Thursday behind the health center building from 10 AM - 2 PM (or less time if the vaccine supply runs out.)

This outreach **WILL** be open not only for students, but also **STAFF** and **FACULTY**

(1) USC students/staff/faculty will need to bring their ID

(2) You will have to be in one of the **PRIORITY GROUPS** (listed above) to get the vaccine.

(3) The charges will be \$10 for students and \$15 for staff and faculty

(4) If you want their vaccine covered under your health plan, you should to go their own provider or the USC pharmacy when vaccine is available.

Their current supply is very limited and so they encourage those with particular health needs to come early. UPHC hopes to have another supply delivered before January.
