# Instructions

## for Freshmen Only: Academic History

- Enter courses and the grades you earned in each subject category.
- If your school uses a 100-point grading system, do not convert your grades to an A/B/C scale; instead, please record the grades as shown on your transcript.
- Enter "IP" if the course is in progress.
- List only college preparatory classes. [Indicate if a course is Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or College Credit (C). See example below].
- Use the first two columns if your school is on a semester system; if you took a year-long or block schedule class, enter the course name and grade in each column.
- Use the third column for summer classes or for third-trimester courses, if your school is on a trimester calendar. If your summer school class was equivalent to a full-year course, enter the grades separated by a slash (see example below).

Sealed and certified transcripts are considered "official." Unsealed transcripts are "unofficial" but can be used for a preliminary application review. Attach a copy of your transcript to this form and mail it with your application. If obtaining a copy of your transcript will delay mailing your application, you may send the transcript under separate cover, using Form 7, page 17.

### Acceptable College Preparatory Courses and Categories

#### English Literature and Composition:

Expository writing and composition, literature (American, British, world, contemporary, classics, etc.), poetry, individual authors (Shakespeare, Joyce, etc.), language arts.

#### Mathematics:

Courses beginning with Algebra I or higher, including math analysis, calculus, discrete math, elementary functions, geometry, precalculus, sequential math, trigonometry.

#### Foreign and Classical Languages:

Languages other than English, in which the instruction includes grammar, composition, reading and aural skills.

#### Social Sciences and History:

Courses in national, state and local politics or government, anthropology, civics, contemporary problems, current affairs, economics, geography, history (U.S., ancient, European, Western civilization, specific countries, Renaissance, etc.), international relations, logic, psychology, sociology, urban affairs, world cultures.

#### Natural Sciences:

Anatomy, astronomy, biology, chemistry, earth science, ecology, environmental science, integrated science sequence, life science, marine biology, oceanography, physical science, physics, physiology, zoology.

#### Humanities:

Art history/appreciation; classics; dramatic literature; introduction to theatre; film history; music (appreciation, history, theory); philosophy; second-, third- or fourth-year studio art classes in ceramics; drawing; painting; photography; printmaking or sculpture.

#### Religion:

Church history, Judaic/Talmudic studies, comparative religion, Old/New Testament, the Bible as literature, the Koran.

#### Academic Electives:

Computer science, journalism, speech.

**Do Not List:** Classes in drama production and stage craft; music ensembles such as band, choir, glee club, jazz band or orchestra; leadership; physical education; computer applications, keyboarding; consumer math, business and accounting courses; newspaper and yearbook staff positions; debate team; teaching assistantships.

#### Exceptions

**Home School:** If you are a home-schooled student, please provide us with detailed syllabi of your courses, names of textbooks, names and credentials of instructors, details of any assistance you are receiving or curriculum you are following through any public or private agency, and any additional information that may be helpful.

**Non-U.S. Educational System:** If your secondary school does not follow the U.S. educational system, do not complete this form. Please state the name of your secondary school and sign your name on the form. Attach the form to any certificates, school records, diplomas, etc., that you are sending as part of your academic history.
