Mr. Martin's acknowledged leadership in the advancement of structural engineering technology has led to his appointment to such prestigious professional groups such as the UCLA Seismic Review Council and UCLA Seismic Engineering Oversight Committee, the Advisory Panel to the State of California Governor's Seismic Safety Commission, and the OSHPD Hospital Building Safety Board.
