Responsibilities:

- Understand the External Pharmacy Review requirements as stated in QAIP.
- Review all On Lok participants drug regimen/profiles every quarter.
 - Upon review of drug regimens, make recommendations to prescribing physicians, whenever possible, for a cost-effective and clinically appropriate drug regimen.
 - Follow through on recommendations to assess compliance level and/or response level of prescribing physician to the changes requested.
 - Report findings to Health Plan Director and Medical Director quarterly.
- Work with IS to ensure accurate PDE (prescription data event) reporting to CMS for On Lok's Part D program(s).
- Prepare for, attend, and lead P&T committee meetings.
- Assist with drug usage guideline decisions at P&T committee meetings by preparing and presenting short drug and therapeutic class monographs at P&T committee meetings.
- Provide in-service to Medical and Nursing staff as requested.

Requirements:

- PharmD required.
- 2-3 years working in managed care clinical pharmacy setting.
