Position Summary:

The LACRC is looking for two highly motivated, well-organized leaders to join its Family Service Department at 100% FTE. Position will be located at our Antelope Valley Office satellite office. Benefits include health, dental, and long-term care insurance; Retirement plans; tuition remission at USC for self, spouse, and/or children; and more. Competitive salary.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

The primary responsibility for this position will include conducting assessments and family consultations in the caregiver's home; facilitate support groups, provide short-term counseling, and provide psycho-educational classes for caregivers and professionals. Site supervisor required to take six hours of clinical supervision course.

Must have current CA driver's license, car, and proof of insurance, as position requires local travel for in-home assessments. Must be able to travel out of town and overnight three to four times a year for several days for training conferences and retreats.

Preferred experience: 2 years of work with brain impaired adults and their families; 2 years of management in healthcare and/or social service field. Bilingual ability a plus.

Minimum education: Master's Degree in Social Work, Gerontology or related field. Experience may substitute for education.
