



**Job Posting:** Clinical Coach, Consultant

St. Barnabas Senior Services Center has been awarded a grant to institute the *Healthy Ideas* depression intervention program for seniors through its social work/case management program. Healthy IDEAS (**I**dentifying **D**epression, **E**mpowering **A**ctivities for **S**eniors) is an evidenced-based program developed and administered by Care For Elders at Baylor University, Houston, Texas. The program is designed to equip local social work case managers with the skills and resources to be able to deliver the intervention with older adults and to assure adherence and competence with individual social work case managers. This is a consultant position reporting to the Director of Social Services. The qualifications for this key position are as follows.

**Qualifications:**

- Candidate may come from one or more of the following professional backgrounds: clinical social work, psychology, psychiatric nursing or psychiatry.

**Requirements:**

Clinical Coach has two major goals: (1) To support the staff in developing confidence and acquiring skills to deliver the intervention with older adults. (2) To assure adherence and competence of individual social work case managers to conduct the intervention as outlined and proven.

**What is expected of the Coach/Clinical Consultant:**

1. The Clinical Coach is desired but not required to attend the 2-day Healthy IDEAS training seminar held at St. Barnabas and delivered by a member of the Healthy IDEAS implementation and administration staff from Houston. This will enable the Clinical Coach to have a much better understanding of both the program and to have the opportunity to develop rapport with the social workers she/he will be the Clinical Coach for. The expected date for this event will be Tuesday and Wednesday, October 25-26.
2. The coach will be required to commit to a minimum of (2) 2 hour sessions to perform case review, as well as guidance and support of the social workers within the first four months of the program's November inauguration. And then the Clinical Coach will need to be available at least by phone on an "as-needed" basis as social work case managers develop their skills and confidence. This might involve an additional five hours.

**Position starts:** Monday, October 3, 2011 and will conclude at the end of February 2012.
