The Division of Health Promotion, Disease Prevention and Epidemiology invites applications from qualified candidates for clinical-track and tenure-track positions from **ASSISTANT** to **ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR** level in Pediatric Dentistry. Responsibilities may include teaching at both the predoctoral and postdoctoral levels at the School of Dentistry as well as affiliate hospitals, clinics and community sites.

**PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY (Clinical Track):** Candidates should have a DDS or DMD degree, a certificate of specialization in pediatric dentistry and be a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry or board-eligible. Candidates with additional training and experience in clinical or basic science research are strongly encouraged to apply.

**PEDIATRIC DENTISTRY (Tenure Track):** Candidates should have a DDS or DMD degree, and a certificate of specialization in pediatric dentistry. Preference will be given to candidates with a Ph.D. in the biological sciences, or candidates with a strong record of accomplishments in research. Successful applicants will be expected to establish vigorous academic programs of high-quality research, to obtain extramural research funds, and to participate in teaching at the pre- and postdoctoral levels. Candidates with training and experience in conducting clinical research are encouraged to apply.
