



DIVISION OF PRIMARY ORAL HEALTH CARE *(Dental Material Scientist)*

The Division of Primary Oral Health Care at the USC School of Dentistry invites applications from qualified candidates for a clinical or tenure-track faculty position in the area of dental material sciences.

Applicants should have a demonstrated interest, expertise and training in materials sciences. Candidates with training and a degree in engineering are particularly encouraged to apply. A DDS/DMD degree and postgraduate training in prosthodontics or other dental specialties is preferred but not required. Candidates with a dental degree and a valid license to practice dentistry may have the privilege to participate in clinical teaching and patient care. The appointment level (assistant, associate or full professor) will be determined based on the qualification of the candidate.

The successful candidate will be expected to develop and teach dental material courses at both predoctoral and post-graduate levels and to conduct innovative clinical research in applied dental materials. Opportunities for collaboration at the School of Dentistry in the areas of restorative dentistry, periodontology and biofilms as well as interdisciplinary collaborations with the Viterbi School of Engineering are expected.
