



DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM **(Clinical-Track and Tenure-Track Positions)**

The Division of Health Promotion, Disease Prevention & Epidemiology invites applications from qualified candidates for clinical-track and tenure-track positions from ASSISTANT to ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR level in Dental Hygiene. We are seeking individuals with a proven record of excellence in research, teaching, and related scholarly activities. Responsibilities will include didactic and clinical teaching, as well as participating in and/or establishing a vigorous, externally funded research program.

DENTAL HYGIENE (Clinical Track): Candidates should have a R.D.H. and a M.S. and must be eligible for licensure in California as a Dental Hygienist. Two years of successful teaching experience in an accredited dental hygiene program preferred. Responsibilities will include didactic and clinical teaching, curriculum development, and mentoring of students and faculty.

DENTAL HYGIENE (Tenure Track): Qualified candidates will have a R.D.H. and a M.S. or Ph.D. (Ph.D. is preferred) and must be eligible for licensure in California as a Dental Hygienist. Successful applicants will be expected to establish vigorous academic programs of high-quality research and to obtain extramural research funds. Responsibilities will include didactic and clinical teaching, curriculum development, and mentoring of students and faculty.
