

Fixed Pros & Operative Dentistry (ADA Codes D6200 – D6999) and (ADA Codes D2000 - D2999)

- Complete 3 clinical assists in Fixed Prost in daily work.
 - Complete 3 clinical assists in Oper Dentistry in daily work.
 - Complete 3 clinical assists for Oper/Fixed performance evaluations.
- Total of 9 clinical assists in Fixed Prosthodontics and Operative*

Optional: 1 patient for occlusal splint therapy.

A total of 20 indirect restorations (1 indirect restoration = 8 eus. Types of indirect restorations: Anterior and Posterior restorations including a minimum of 3 units in Fixed Prosthodontics (FP), to include at least one traditional Fixed Partial Denture. Implant crowns will be credited in FP – 6000 Code, NOTE: implants will have one procedure credit for the prep and surgical placement of the implant, AND one procedure credit for the cementation of the final restorations. THUS if a student is able to complete an implant procedure from initiation to cementation TWO procedure credits in the FP category will be earned.

ALL Fixed and Operative procedures started must be completed prior to sign-out for graduation.

Each student is required to complete 2 core build ups and one cast post. These procedures should be on endodontically treated teeth. Only one cast post will be given credit toward the total of 20 indirect restorations.

Only six porcelain laminate veneers and two semi-direct (indirect) composite restorations will count toward the total of 20 indirect restorations.

125 clinical activities involving a wide range of experiences in operative dentistry involving services to single teeth to preserve or restore their health, form and function, in the major options of surface remineralization, direct and indirect composite resin, amalgam, indirect porcelain and tooth colored non-porcelain, indirect cast and ceramometal. Pit and fissure sealants will NOT be counted towards the 125 activities expected. All activities can be achieved at any USC Dental School remote site.

Operative and Fixed Prosthodontics
Performance Evaluations (PE)

2 amalgam restorations (one may be on an extracted tooth, must be passed before doing the patient procedure)

5 direct composite restorations (one must be a class 2 or a class 3)

3 indirect cast restorations: preparations, impressions, provisionals

3 cast restoration cementations

Simulation examinations- amalgam restorations on extracted teeth

Comprehensive Restorative Exit Examination (passing is prerequisite for NBII eligibility)
