<b>New Faculty Recruitment</b>	Variable	Candidate must be the first choice of an open national-level search or judged to be at the top of his/her field.	No specific deadline
<b>Major Support for Current Faculty</b>	Up to \$25,000. Requests for higher amounts must be approved by the WiSE Director prior to submission.	Any USC faculty member in the sciences or engineering. Candidates may receive the award once every three years.	Online application must be completed and submitted by <b>January 27</b> .
<b>Lloyd Armstrong, Jr. Endowed Chair</b>	\$50,000/year for 5 years	Candidates must be recommended by the school dean and have the strong support of the WiSE faculty.	No specific deadline
<b>Supplemental Faculty Support</b>	\$2,500 annually	Tenured and tenure-track faculty or full-time research faculty may apply directly. Tenured and tenure track faculty may apply on behalf of other non-tenure track faculty.	No specific deadline
<b>Post Doctoral Support</b>	Stipend augmentation of \$25,000/year for 2 years	Doctoral degree, a statement of faculty mentorship and support and WiSE justification.	**USC College: <b>December 2 &amp; April 28</b> VSoE: <b>February 15 &amp; August 15</b>
<b>Graduate Top-off Fellowship</b>	Top-off awards of \$5,000/year for 2 years	Incoming Ph.D. must be offered some other substantial form of support (e.g. fellowship or a 50% teaching or research assistantship). Must be nominated for this award by their department.	**USC College: <b>March 3</b> VSoE: <b>February 15</b>
<b>Merit Fellowships for Current Ph.D. Students</b>	\$5,000 for one year	Students must have passed qualifying exam and be funded by a 50% research or teaching assistantship or fellowship. Must be nominated for this award by faculty advisor.	**Department chairs should submit nominations by <b>March 3</b> .
<b>Travel Grants for Ph.D. Students and Postdoctoral Scholars</b>	Up to \$300 for travel in CA, \$500 for travel in US, \$700 for international travel, provided the advisor pays the other half	Candidate must be full-time grad student or postdoc in VSoE or within science or math department of USC College. Must be an author on the abstract and present at the meeting.	Application is due no later than one month prior to travel date.
<b>Undergraduate Research Grants</b>	Fall and Spring awards of \$2,500. Summer award of \$5,000. \$500 of each award dedicated to advisor support.	Students must be enrolled at USC on a full-time basis during the semester in which they receive the award, in the case of summer the previous semester.	**USC College: <b>January 16, April 1 &amp; August 28</b> VSoE: <b>November 15, April 1 &amp; August 1</b> .

<b>Child Care Subsidy</b>	Awards are \$4,000 annually.	Any doctoral student, postdoc, or faculty member is eligible. Applicant must be in good standing at the University and have primary child care responsibilities for a child, infant-preschool age.	No specific deadline
<b>Support for Faculty for Childbirth and Adoption</b>	Variable	Tenured and tenure-track faculty in the sciences or engineering.	No specific deadline
<b>Fellowship to Accommodate Pregnancy for Ph.D. &amp; Postdocs</b>	One semester 50% fellowship at minimum stipend level / 50% of 12-month salary for one semester	Postdocs with full funding and full-time Ph.D. students with 50% time assistantship funding who become pregnant and are enrolled in a WiSE eligible department.	No specific deadline
