

GUIDELINES for

The Rockwell Dennis Hunt and University Staff Club Scholarships

Students nominated for the Rockwell Dennis Hunt Award and Trophy will also be considered for the University Staff Club Scholarship. Nominees for the Rockwell Dennis Hunt Award and the University Staff Club Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. have completed a minimum of three years of undergraduate work at USC;
and
2. have earned a bachelor's degree at USC within the last five years (2001-2006);
and
3. be currently working toward a master's degree or doctorate at the University of Southern California during 2006-07.

All Applicants must:

1. embody the University's traditions and objectives as determined by overall performance during the periods of undergraduate and graduate enrollment;
and
2. be likely to best represent the University in the future as an alumnus.

Qualified applicants should submit the Rockwell Dennis Hunt Award application, accompanied by a nomination letter from a dean, director or department chair **and** two letters of recommendation from USC faculty. An up-to-date unofficial USC transcript must also be submitted with the application. The award will be presented at the Spring 2007 Honor's Convocation.
