

HEMATOPATHOLOGY FELLOWSHIP

Description: The USC Department of Pathology offers a one-year ACGME-accredited fellowship with comprehensive training in morphologic hematopathology and laboratory hematology. The program emphasizes training in lymph node and bone marrow pathology, flow cytometric immunophenotyping, and immunohistochemistry. The fellow is exposed to the full spectrum of laboratory hematology - hematopathology analytic methods including automated cell counting, variant hemoglobin analysis, special coagulation-platelet function testing, conventional cytogenetics and molecular genetic methods.

Requirements: Interested candidates should have completed AP/CP or AP training, and be eligible for licensure in California.
