COURSE DESCRIPTION

This will be the first course offered in Southern California to provide pulmonologists and cardiothoracic surgeons a state-of-the-art, practical overview of new and evolving techniques that are recognized as useful diagnostic and therapeutic interventions. The techniques can be performed with a flexible fiberoptic bronchoscope for patients with a variety of endobronchial lesions. At the beginning of the course, three faculty experts will present brief lectures describing the techniques. During the second half of the program, participants will have the opportunity to observe demonstrations by faculty and practice the techniques using airway models.

OBJECTIVES

At the completion of the program, participants should be able to:

1. list the indications for using airway stent devices and the potential difficulties in placing these devices,
2. list the indications for using argon photocoagulation and cryotherapy for airway lesions and the potential difficulties with these techniques, and
3. list the indications for using bronchoscopic fine needle aspirations and the potential difficulties of the technique.

Tuition: \$75.00 (non-refundable). Includes course materials and parking. Directions and a Parking Pass will be sent to registrants prior to the program.
