COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is designed for physician assistants preparing to take either the entry level Physician Assistant National Certifying Exam (PANCE), or the Physician Assistant Recertifying Exam (PANRE, or Pathway II) given by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants, Inc. Our goals are to provide the participants with a course that is focused on key content areas in Primary Care that include diagnosis and management of common disorders, and offer technical skills workshops designed to enhance the clinical practice of physician assistants, nurse midwives, nurse practitioners and physicians.

Course participants are asked to evaluate each speaker on the content and delivery of each lecture.

EKG WORKSHOP

This optional two-hour workshop will provide a review of EKG interpretation with case histories followed by hands-on evaluation and identification of actual rhythmstrips. An instructor will be available for immediate feedback. Two identical sessions will be offered (see schedule). In order for the workshop to be held, there must be a minimum of 12 registrants. Enrollment is limited to 25 per session. The fee is \$75.00 (non-refundable unless session cancelled by USC). Pre-registration and pre-payment are required.

RADIOLOGY WORKSHOP

This optional two-hour workshop will consist of a review of common normal and abnormal patterns seen in x-rays of the chest, abdomen and extremities. It will include a hands-on portion to identify these patterns on actual films. Two identical sessions will be offered. In order for the workshop to be held, there must be a minimum of 12 registrants. Enrollment is limited to 25 per session. The fee is \$50.00 (non-refundable unless session cancelled by USC). Pre-registration and pre-payment are required.

SUTURING WORKSHOP

This optional three-hour workshop is designed to improve basic suturing skills and will include lecture, demonstration and hands-on experience. All equipment will be provided. Pigs' feet will be utilized for both demonstration and practice. Enrollment is limited to 20. Only one session will be given. The fee is \$75.00 (non-refundable unless session cancelled by USC). There must be a minimum of 15 registrants or the workshop will be canceled. Pre-registration and pre-payment are required.
