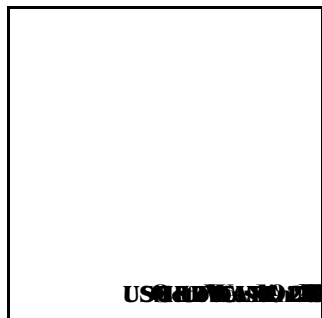

- **U.S. Citizens** require proof of citizenship and an official photo ID for entry into Mexico. Citizens of other countries should contact the Mexican Consulate for Visa and entry requirements.
