Program Description

This program will cover a broad spectrum of women's health from early pregnancy through the birth process. Presentations include fetal heart rate monitoring and VBAC. Preterm labor and its prevention will be explored. Clinical management will be illustrated by actual case presentations prompting audience response and participation. Clinical management of medical disorders will include respiratory disease, autoimmune disorders, viral infections and hyperemesis gravidarum. The rapidly changing field of prenatal diagnosis will be reviewed and critiqued. Contemporary approaches to recurrent stillbirth and the contraceptive options for the woman with medical complications will complete the spectrum of contemporary reproductive practices.

Program Objectives

Following the presentations, participants should be able to:

- < discuss the place of VBAC in current obstetric practice;
- < outline the clinical management of medical disorders seen in pregnancy including respiratory and autoimmune disorders as well as viral infections;
- < describe the approach to women at risk for preterm birth and discuss known methods of prevention and management;
- < outline diagnostic and therapeutic approaches for women with viral infections in pregnancy including hepatitis and HIV and list contraceptive methods available for women with medical complications.
