- Nominees should have a history of well-known contributions to society, impactful public service, or recognition for a high achievement in the public eye (either in the public, private, or nonprofit sector)
- The school has a special interest in identifying alumni across diverse professions, age ranges, and ethnic backgrounds.

PLEASE SUBMIT YOUR NOMINATION(S) BY MARCH 1, 2010.

Nominations must include a narrative or outline of an individual's contributions to SPPD, his or her professional achievements, and his or her philanthropic and community achievements. The nominee's previous honors and awards may also be listed.
