

# AlcoholEdu™ for College

The University of Southern California **requires every incoming undergraduate student to complete AlcoholEdu for College**, an online science-based alcohol abuse prevention program. To complete AlcoholEdu for College, you will need a computer with audio capabilities and access to the Internet. An information sheet, detailing the minimum technical requirements, is available on the AlcoholEdu for College log-in page. We recommend you review this document prior to logging into the course.

**Part 1 of the course will be available in mid-July. Part 1 must be completed before coming to campus to start classes. The completion deadline for new incoming Fall 2008 students: Tuesday, August 19, 2008; new incoming Spring 2008 students: Sunday, January 11, 2009.** The log-in ID, provided below, is specific to “first year students” or “transfer students.” Please use the correct log-in ID. Parents have the option to take this course, should they choose to do so, but are not required to complete the course. We have provided parents with a separate “parent” log-in ID.

For students to receive credit for completing this requirement, it is essential that all participants use their correct log-in ID.

**Part 2 completion deadline for new incoming Fall 2008 students: Friday, October 3, 2008; new incoming Spring 2008 students: Wednesday, February 25, 2009.** About 45 days after completing part 1, you will receive e-mail instructions on taking Part 2.

## Directions for completing AlcoholEdu for College:

1. Go to: <http://college.alcoholedu.com/login.aspx>
2. Under “New User,” enter the following log-in ID that applies to you:

3. Click “Sign Up.”
4. On the registration page you will have the opportunity to create your own AlcoholEdu for College account using your e-mail address and a password of your choice. At this time, you will also need to enter your 10-digit **USC Student ID** number, **located on your Student ID card**. If you do not enter your official 10-digit Student ID number, you will not receive credit for taking this course.
5. You may log in and out of the course at the completion of each section. The end of each section is marked with a “Next” button. You must click the “Next” button to save your information. **DO NOT log out until you have clicked the “Next” button, or you will be required to repeat that section again.**
6. When you return, log in as a “Returning User” and enter the same e-mail address and password you created when you first logged into the course.

Should you experience any difficulties or require support, the AlcoholEdu Online Technical Support Center is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Simply click on the “Technical Help” button located in the upper right-hand corner of every AlcoholEdu screen. You do not need to be logged into the course to access the Technical Help Site.
