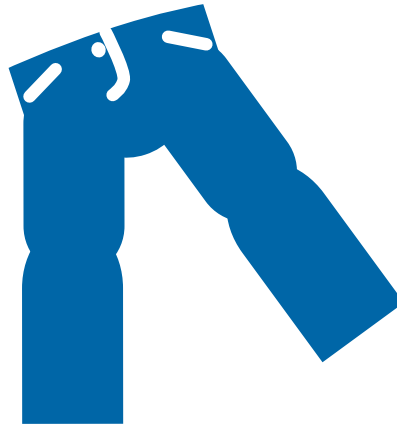

HISTORY OF DENIM DAY

In 1999 the Italian Supreme Court overturned a rape conviction because the victim was wearing tight jeans at the time of the assault. The justices stated that the victim must have aided her attacker in removing the jeans, implying consent. The following day, female members of the Italian Parliament and their supporters wore jeans in protest. Wearing jeans on the anniversary of the ruling has become an international symbol of protest against misconceptions of sexual violence.
