Please note that the scholarship is not limited to these populations.

You will be directed to a secure site that is linked to **Tommy's** online scholarship application. Please follow the instructions provided to either upload or type your letter in the space provided.

Please keep in mind that your letter of recommendation must be received by 11:59pm PST on the appropriate deadline:

Freshman Applicants - February 13, 2009
Transfer & Graduate Applicants - May 13, 2009

If we do not receive the letter by this date, **Tommy Trojans's** application will be considered incomplete and will NOT be reviewed.

USC TOPPING SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS & SELECTION CRITERIA

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, candidates must:

- Apply for USC admission for Fall 2009 as a freshman, transfer or graduate student,
- Have high financial need (usually defined as having a need greater than or equal to the cost of tuition by the USC Financial Aid Office), AND
- Demonstrate community awareness.

If possible, your letter of recommendation should address the following selection criteria:

- Financial Need
- First-Generation College Student Status
(Mother or father's highest level of education)
- Community Awareness
- Volunteer Efforts
- Extraordinary Circumstances
